## Important Safety Announcement!

We still have a number of parents parking on the yellow zig zags opposite the school during drop off and pick up times. This is not only illegal parking, it can result in a serious safety issue where pedestrians especially with pushchairs can often not cross safely to and from school. We have mentioned this several times over the last academic year, but unfortunately there are cars parked on the zig zag lines outside school most days. Ultimately, we do not want to see a child from our school, or indeed a pre-school child injured or worse as a result. We are working with Norfolk Constabulary to help find a solution to this problem.

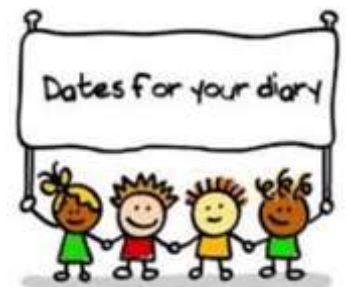
