Dear Parents and Carers,

On **Friday 26th May**, our Jaguar class are scheduled to visit Pensthorpe Natural Park for a day to be inspired by the wonderful wildlife. They will have the opportunity to go pond dipping and participate in a minibeast hunt.

Costings:

Transport - Coach £170

Venue - £7.95

Number of pupils attending – 31

Cost per pupil - £13.43

Subsidised cost per pupil - £8.50

There is a **voluntary contribution of £8.50** required to cover the cost of the visit. On this occasion the school is subsidising the cost of the coach. We must state that if an adequate amount of voluntary donations are not received the trip may not be able to go ahead. If your child is in receipt of pupil premium funding there is a reduced voluntary contribution. As always, please pay via the ParentMail app, this system will also ask you to confirm consent for your child to participate.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch and a bottle of water to drink. If you wish to order a school packed lunch please email the office on office@foulshamprimary.org.uk with your choice of filling (ham, tuna or cheese). These will be pre-ordered. Please do not order via the Pupil Asset app on this occasion.

We ask the children to wear school uniform sweatshirts or cardigans with jog trousers/leggings or jeans. They will need sensible footwear for walking outside. Please make sure children have a waterproof jacket and if the weather is kind, they will need a sunhat with sun lotion applied before school.
