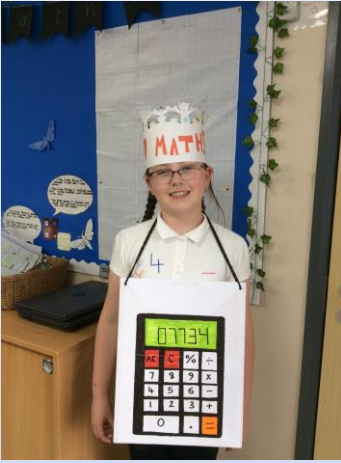
## Meet the chicks
