## **Hippodrome Circus Christmas Spectacular**

## **Circus & Water Show**

## Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that on <u>Thursday 12th December 2024</u>, the whole federation will be attending the Hippodrome Circus in Great Yarmouth (*St. Georges Road, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk, NR30 2EU*). The show is one of the biggest Christmas productions in Europe and combines the festive spirit of Christmas with the breath-taking magic of the circus.

The trip will take place during normal school hours, so children should arrive and be collected at the usual times. The coach will leave school at 9:15am and return for 2:30pm. Children should wear full school uniform for the trip and bring a packed lunch (including a water bottle) – NO fizzy drinks please. If you would like to order a school packed lunch for your child, please ensure this is ordered in advance and inform the office.

The total cost of this visit will be £10.00 per child. Families eligible for Pupil Premium will receive a 50% reduction, meaning the cost will be £5.00 per child. This amount nearly covers the entrance fee for the event. Please make payment via the Arbor (no cash payments will be accepted). May we remind you that no child will be excluded because of cost but unless sufficient contributions are received, the trip will not be able to take place.

Costings:

Venue - £11 per seat

Transport - £765

Number of pupils attending – 69

Cost per pupil - £22.08

## Voluntary donation per pupil £10 (pupil premium £5)

This is a whole federation trip and all three schools will be closed on this day. If your child is not attending the Christmas show, they will need to remain at home, as there will be no staff available at school to supervise.

Unfortunately, we will not be able to invite any parent helpers on the trip as all school staff will be attending, and there is no available seating on the coach.
